**Next Sunday we will be celebrating the Lord's Supper** during our online worship service. We invite you to **have some bread and juice on hand** that morning so that we might together take part, from our own homes, in this shared meal.

As we gradually reopen our campus this summer, we will be offering **two in-person worship services each Sunday, beginning Sunday, June 20**. These will be a **10:00 a.m. service in the Sanctuary** and **4:00 p.m. Jazz at Four service in Buchanan Chapel**. Because there will be limited seating for both services (250 in the Sanctuary)—as well as self-certification requirements—those who would like to worship in person will be asked to **preregister online**. We are currently working on setting up the registration system, and as soon as it is open for use, we will send details to those on our News @ Fourth Church email list (subscribe at [www.bit.ly/newsfromfpc](http://www.bit.ly/newsfromfpc) if you do not already receive it weekly) as well as post an easily accessible link on the website. **Masks will be required at all times for all present in the building**, and **social distancing** will also be required.
