Community-Supported Agriculture (CSA) is also known as "subscription farming."

You buy a share, or subscription, from a local farmer just like you buy a subscription to your favorite magazine or newspaper—but instead of receiving a magazine each week, you receive a "share" of fresh, locally grown produce.

The Chicago Lights Urban Farm CSA "Salad Shares" allow members to have direct access to high-quality, fresh, organic produce grown on-site. In return, those shares help support the Farm and its many communityoriented programs.



## What is a Share?

Our Salad Share is for 1–2 people and is composed of mixed, gourmet greens along with seasonal produce that may accent salads.

#### For example,

**Spring:** radishes, baby carrots, sweet peas, herbs, lettuce mix

**Summer/Fall:** spicy greens, kale, collards, lettuce, tomatoes, peppers, cucumbers, edible flowers, carrots, salad turnips, herbs

Shares are available each Saturday, June 28 through November 8, for pickup at the Farm or, at additional cost, for delivery.

For delivery, you must live or work in the delivery zone (see map) or choose Fourth Presbyterian Church (Chestnut and North Michigan Avenue) as a delivery location.

#### **Full Shares** (\$300) 20 weeks of Salad Shares

(June 28–November 8)

#### Half Shares (\$150) 10 Weeks of Salad Shares (you choose: June 28–August 30 or September 6–November 8)

### As a member, you will

- receive fresh vegetables and fruits
- know where and how your food is grown and who grows it
- receive discounts on purchases at the Farm Stand
- directly benefit your local community by supporting open, green spaces and boosting the local economy

Please note that each season also carries the risk that a given crop may fail due to circumstances beyond our control. As your farmers, we grow a wide diversity of crops to the best of our ability, aiming for a bounty to always fill your share.
