

WORSHIP NOTES

Guest preacher Monsignor Kenneth Velo, a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago, serves as Senior Executive of Catholic Collaboration for DePaul University and as President of the Big Shoulders Fund, which supports inner-city Catholic schools in Chicago. He also participates in pastoral ministry at Old Saint Patrick's Church. Ordained in 1973, he was appointed to St. Angela Parish in Chicago, and in March 1996, Pope John Paul II named him Prelate of Honor with the title of Monsignor. Monsignor Velo has also served as vice chancellor of the Archdiocese and executive assistant to Joseph Cardinal Bernardin.

The textile banners and pulpit parament, "Unweavings," created by Laurie Wohl, were commissioned by Fourth Church for use during the liturgical season of Ordinary Time, the longest season of the church year (the season between Epiphany and Lent and between Pentecost and Advent). Through their combination of scripture texts and images, these banners celebrate and elevate the perception of the sacred in the "ordinary" as we make our faith journey day to day.
