We will be gathering again this evening for Christmas Eve Lessons and Carols at 8:00 and 10:00 p.m. There will not be socially distanced seating at either of these services, but the 8:00 service will be livestreamed at www.fourthchurch.org ** If you would like to watch our online Christmas Eve Children's Pageant from earlier today, you will find that on our website. ** Tomorrow we will also have an in-person Christmas Day service at 10:00 a.m. This service will be in-person only, with a socially distanced section at the front of the Sanctuary. Discounted parking on Christmas Day will be available at 900 N. Michigan with a validation ticket purchased at the church that morning for \$20 (cash or check only).
