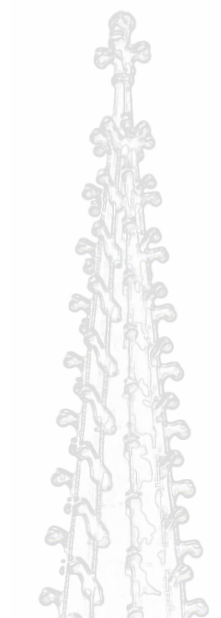

A prolific composer, in 1988 he wrote "Rubrics," a five-movement suite for organ that has become one of his most popular pieces. Each movement in it is based on a rubric—a sentence of instruction—from the *Book of Common Prayer* for the Episcopal Church in America. The fourth movement, "The Peace may be exchanged," was played at the funeral service of former President Ronald Reagan at the Washington National Cathedral.
