\* The doors open for worship on Sundays a half hour before each service. For the 4:00 service, access is only by the Delaware doors to the Gratz Center. \* Sunday parking at 900 N. Michigan (access from Rush or Walton) is available at the rate of \$9 for 6 hours between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. (and \$18 for up to 12 hours).
