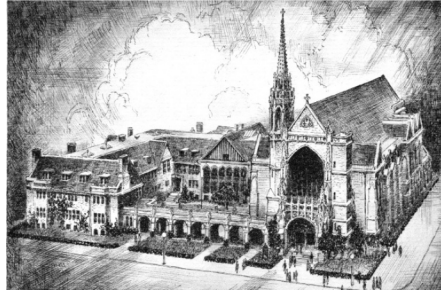
YOU BELONG HERE

LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS

A campus landscaping project begins this week! Following a thorough evaluation, the Property Committee has partnered with Homan Grown Chicago, a local, woman-owned firm, to enhance the beauty and sustainability of our grounds.

What to Expect:

Native Plantings: We are replacing underperforming greenery with climate-appropriate, native landscaping.

Ivy Removal: English ivy will be removed from the grounds and buildings. While iconic, it is an invasive species that damages our historic stone and mortar.

Timeline: Cleanup and removal will conclude by late April, with new installations following in late May or early June.
